### Today's Topic: Word of the Day ("WOD")

Three quick thoughts about the WOD:

#### 1. Purpose

- a. It is often used to build our vocabulary
- b. But it goes much deeper...
- c. More on that in a second

#### 2. Best Practices

- a. Pick a word commonly used: "Inspirational," not "Prehensile"
  - i. Who will ever use "Prehensile?"
  - ii. What is the point of choosing a word no one has heard of and no one will ever use again?
- b. **List the WOD** on your meeting agenda
- c. **Define the WOD** on your meeting agenda
- d. If your club uses a "Theme of a Meeting," select a word that maps to that theme
- e. At the beginning of the meeting, **paste the word/definition in the chatbox** for greater visibility, increased use

#### 3. Business Application

- a. Everything we do in Toastmasters has a direct application to the business world
  - b. This includes the WOD
  - c. The WOD is more than just building vocabulary
    - i. That's important, yes
    - ii. But it's really about "Top of Mind"
  - d. What do you want your team members thinking about today? This week? That's the "Top of the Mind"
  - e. **The WOD of the day is an exercise for Toastmasters to practice "Top of Mind"**
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
