All nominees interviewed by the DLC were put forward as District Officer Candidates for the 2022-2023 Toastmasters year. All candidates put forward are qualified and eligible.

- A qualified candidate is a candidate that meets the qualifications as outlined in the District Administrative Bylaws.
- An eligible candidate is a candidate that has been evaluated by the DLC, as referenced in Protocol 9.0.
- To be nominated from the floor, candidates must be both qualified and eligible. Floor candidates must have completed the District Leadership Committee process and must be nominated by a member of the District Council or their proxy holder.

The DLC was impressed with the quality of nominees and their desire to be a District 13 Toastmasters leader. We support their candidacy and are confident that they will serve District 13 to the best of their abilities.
